We welcome you as a singer with Kearsarge Chorale for our 3:00 PM, November 23, 2024 performance. The following information summarizes the commitment that you are making as a singer.

I: Rehearsals

The first rehearsal in preparation for the November concert will be September 2nd in the First Baptist Church Choir Room, 461 Main St., New London, NH. Please arrive at 6:30 p.m. to check in and receive your music. (You may choose to register early at the Meet and Greet prior to the Annual Meeting at 6:30 on August 26th in the First Baptist Church Choir Room.) Subsequent Monday evening rehearsals will run from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. with sectional rehearsals as needed.

Dress rehearsal is mandatory; anyone who does not attend the dress rehearsal will not be permitted to sing in the concert. The date and time of the dress rehearsal will be announced in September.

Concert dress will be announced in October.

Independent work at home is expected.

Note: Everyone who rehearses for a particular concert is expected to sing in that concert.

II: Attendance

The importance of regular attendance at both plenary and sectional rehearsals cannot be stressed enough. Each singer’s voice contributes to the characteristic sound of the ensemble. Our most important task is to build and refine that sound in plenary rehearsals. You and your voice are essential to the blend and stability of the Chorale. The Section Deans will take attendance at all rehearsals. Please notify your Section Dean ahead of time if you must miss a rehearsal. If a singer misses more than three rehearsals in a season, that singer will be asked to meet with the Artistic Director to discuss his/her participation in the concert. Singers should check the Chorale’s website (www.kearsargechorale.org) for information, including schedules and snow closings. Just click on the “Members” tab.

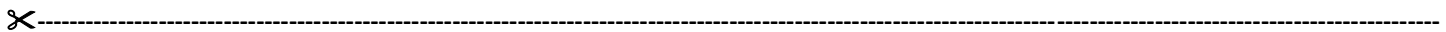
III: Dues and Music Purchase (Note: Students are exempt from paying dues.)

Dues are \$50 per season and are due on or before the end of the third plenary rehearsal.

Music purchase: If you have a copy of *Mass in Blue*, please bring it to the first rehearsal. If you don’t have this music, a copy will be provided by the Chorale. A donation of \$20 to reimburse the Chorale for the cost of ordering additional music would be appreciated, but is entirely optional. (If you do donate \$20 for the music, you are welcome to keep it as your own.)
